#### Life and Death, Here and Now

Romans 8:5-11 March 13, 2022

## Two groups of people:

Those whose spirits are alive (who are in the Spirit) & Those who are spiritually dead (in the flesh)

### Notice the trinity:

v. 9 - "The Spirit of God..." "The Spirit of Christ..."

v. 10 - "Christ is in you..."

v. 11 - "the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead... He who raised Jesus from the dead... His Spirit who dwells in you."

### Those whose spirits are alive

Are not in the flesh / controlled by [their] sinful nature (v. 9)

By implication: **Those who are spiritually dead (in the flesh)** are... controlled by [their] sinful nature (v. 9 NLT)

### Those whose spirits are alive

Are controlled by the Spirit (v. 9 NLT)

By implication: **Those who are spiritually dead (in the flesh)** Are [not] controlled by the Spirit (v. 9)

v. 7 - The mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. (NLT - The sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will.)

John 14:15, 21, 23, 24 -

v. 15 - "If you love me, you will keep my commandments."

v. 21 - "Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me...."

v. 23 - Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word...."

v. 24 - "Whoever does not love me does not keep my words...."

John 3:19-21

# Those whose spirits are alive

Have the Spirit of God living in [them] (vv. 9, 11)

**Those who are spiritually dead (in the flesh)** do not have the Spirit of Christ living in them (v. 9)

Ephesians 1:13-14

#### Those whose spirits are alive

**Their spirits live even though your body will die.** (v. 10 NLT - "Even though your body will die because of sin, your spirit is alive.")

By implication: **Those who are spiritually dead**, their spirits are dead even as their bodies live... and will, one day know eternal death...

Revelation 20:12-15

"Born once, die twice... born twice, die once..."

# Those whose spirits are alive

Have been made right with God (v. 10 NLT)

By implication: **Those who are spiritually dead** are not right with God (v. 10 NLT).

**Those who do not have the Spirit of Christ living in them** do not belong to him at all (v. 9 NLT)

Our root problem: alienation from God

## Those whose spirits are alive

Will receive life [in] our mortal bodies (v. 11 ESV)

By implication: **Those who are spiritually dead** will not receive life in their bodies

## The hope of physical resurrection:

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

(Revelation 20:12-15)

A Truth to Remember: You are not controlled by your sinful nature. You are controlled by the Spirit if you have the Spirit of God living in you. (Romans 8:9 NLT)

A Challenge to Consider: Is the desire of your heart to be controlled by the Spirit of God? Is this desire reflected in your daily priorities?
